



Body Numbing Cream Instructions

Prior to Laser Hair Removal & Laser Tattoo Removal Treatments

This compounded topical anesthetic includes multiple numbing agents, including but not limited to ibuprofen. Do not use this medication if you have ever had an allergic reaction to any numbing ingredient such as lidocaine or benzocaine.

Before Application:

- Shave the treatment area before applying the Ultracaine.
- Stir the cream thoroughly before application to ensure all ingredients are properly mixed.
- Apply a thin, even layer to the sensitive treatment area(s) approximately 3 hours before your session.
 - You should see a *slight wet coating* on the skin—this indicates enough product has been applied.
- Allow the cream to absorb and dry as much as possible before covering with clothing.
 - Do not cover with saran wrap or tight-fitting clothing.
- Do not apply Ultracaine to an area larger than your full legs and bikini area (for women) or larger than the entire back (for men).

Important Safety Information

- Do not apply to the face. Please ask for a separate topical if numbing is needed for facial treatments.
- Avoid contact with eyes, nose, or ears. If the medication gets into these areas, rinse immediately with water.
- This product is for external use only.
- Wash your hands with soap and water both before and after application.

- It is possible to experience mild redness, irritation, or swelling at the application site. These effects are temporary and should resolve within a few hours after your treatment.
